Phase II-FORMAT

No Fees Affinity Group and Intel Portal TO LEAD, PROMOTE, REPRESENT AND SUPPORT HIGH SPEED GLOBAL AEROSPACE TRANSPORTATION

- More than 75% of the group:
 - Wishes to remain a “free”:
 - Public information portal
 - Private Membership forum
 - Reference library, intelligence and knowledge depository-portal
- Consensus for the new FF to have a public website with a firewalled access to a “for members only” section
 - Members will be vetted by the Group by sharing their intent-IP to belong to the group, and
 - Members will have a balanced “give-take” commitment to the Group
- The FF Members section will be very close to the format we have today;
 - Quarterly conference calls March-June-September-December
 - Yearly group review Q3-September

Conclusion-Phase II FORMAT

- **New Format will require additional effort-resources from Group's management to:**
 - **Develop the public area**
 - **To enhance the membership area and member's value adding, interactions and sharing gains**
- The FF Transition Team estimates:
 - The costs to lead, manage and execute on this format will be circa USD\$30-50K per year and require a team of 2 executives, part time
 - Will required a minimum 2 year commitment from the Groups' leadershipsponsors to achieve intent in the short terms
 - First term 2014-2015
- The FF Transition team seeks consensus and opens the floor for candidates to execute the Group's new format for the term 2014-2015
 - **Will take expressions of interest from members and public in Sep-Nov 2013-Contact FF Chairs, John Olds and Oscar Garcia**
 - **FF will announce 2014-2015 Leadership-Sponsor on the November telecon**
